#### **Voting Qualifications**

(From By-Laws Article IV, Section B, Paragraph 5)

To be qualified to vote, the member must be a member in good standing as defined by Article II Section D. Any time a vote is taken, the qualifications of Article II Section D shall be read and each person in attendance shall search his or her own conscience and decide whether or not he or she should vote.

#### **Responsibilities of Membership**

(From By-Laws Article II, Section D)
A member in good standing of Crossroads is expected to:

- 1. Assume responsibility for his/her own spiritual nourishment through personal and corporate Bible study and prayer. (Acts 2:42; II Timothy 2:15; I Thessalonians 5:17)
- 2. Participate faithfully in public worship services. (Hebrews 10:25)
- 3. Join the family life of the church in a congregational and/or small group context. (Acts 2:46, 47a)
- 4. Exercise his/her spiritual gifts in specific areas of involvement. (Romans 12:1-8)
- 5. Support the variety of ministries of the church through prayer and service. (Philippians 1:3-5, 18b-19)
- 6. Contribute financially to this congregation in a consistent, generous manner. (I Corinthians 16:1,2; II Corinthians 8:7)
- 7. Share his/her faith personally while supporting others who proclaim the gospel around the world.
  (Acts 8:4; II Corinthians 9:12-15)
- 8. Respond positively to the leadership of the Council of Elders in matters of church policy and discipline. (Hebrews 13:17)
