Week of March 19 - **I am Dependent on God**

Directions: Read through the scripture of the day. If you have the Bible App on your mobile device, try reading the passage in more than one Bible version before you pray and consider the follow-up questions

Daily Readings and Follow-Up Questions:

Monday:

[Read Matthew 26:36-46](#)

- What was Jesus' frame of mind/emotional state at the start of this passage? ...and at the end?
- What does this passage say to you about Jesus' relationship with God?
- When you call God "Father," what images come to mind?
 - Are you able to picture someone with your best interests at heart?

- Are you able to place your care completely in His hands?
- Pray this prayer today: "Father, let your will be done in my life."

Tuesday:

Read Matthew 26:36-46

- How do Jesus' words and actions portray his dependence on God?
- How does this passage inspire you to live and love like Jesus?
- Pray this prayer again today: "Father, let your will be done in my life."

Wednesday:

Read John 17:1-19

- Read today's passage a second time, and highlight or note any portions that stand out to you.
 - What do the highlighted sections tell you about Jesus' relationship with God?
 - What do they tell you about your relationship with Him?
 - What does this passage tell you about your relationship with others?
 - How does it challenge/inspire you?

Thursday:

Read John 17:20-26

- Read today's passage a second time, and highlight or note any portions that stand out to you.
 - What do the highlighted sections tell you about Jesus' relationship with God?
 - What do they tell you about your relationship with Him?
 - What does this passage tell you about your relationship with others?
 - How does it challenge/inspire you?

Friday:

Read Matthew 5, verses 6 and 8

- What do these two verses tell you about God?
- What do these verses reveal about your desires?
- What do they reveal about God's desires for you?
- Pray this prayer today: "Father let your will be done in my life."
