

PRAY *for* YOURSELF

Use the following prayer prompts to ask God to work and move in your life.

PRAY you would make a deeper commitment to know God and draw closer to Him through as you fast and pray, that your life would glorify God.

PRAY you would sense a deep conviction of any area(s) you need to repent of so you can be a holy vessel for God to work in and through.

PRAY for spiritual breakthrough as you seek God's plan for your life and face any temptation, trial, or testing, trusting in His Word to guide you and power to strengthen you.

PRAY to find purpose in your life in ways that seeks first God's Kingdom and cares about the things that are important to Him.

PRAY *for* YOUR FAMILY

Use the following prayer prompts to ask God to work and move in your family.

PRAY that your family would find consistent ways to explore God and his wisdom, connect around the table, and serve their neighbors and church together.

PRAY that parents, caregivers, and Family Ministry leaders (paid & volunteer) would identify one person they could pour into and one person who would be willing to pour into them.

PRAY that God would deeply connect people of all generations within our congregation through worship, volunteering, small groups, service, creativity, prayer, meals, and play.

PRAY *for* OUR CONGREGATION

Use the following prayer prompts to ask God to work and move in our congregation.

PRAY that everyone would be vibrant worshippers making Jesus known wherever they find themselves — whether at home, at work, at church, in their neighborhood, in their community, or anywhere in the world.

PRAY that everyone would diligently study God's Word and commit to being disciples making disciples.

PRAY that everyone would have open hearts, minds, and souls for what God has in store for the future of Crossroads. And through all of this,

PRAY that God would be glorified!

PRAY *for* OUR COMMUNITY

Use the following prayer prompts to ask God to work and move in our community.

On any given night during the winter months, over 100 families are living in their cars, in abandoned houses or on the streets. An emergency shelter for families is being planned for, but we are currently looking for a location.

PRAY that families in our community would remain safe and that we could open an emergency shelter soon.

Families who care for loved ones with disabilities experience many barriers to attending church together.

The more severe the disability, the more likely they are to not even try to attend church.

PRAY that we would be able to develop a plan which would allow everyone who wants to attend Crossroads, the accommodations they need to find community here at Crossroads.

Children removed from their families by DCS often have to wait a day or two before a foster family can be located for placement. During this time, they often stay at the Isaiah 1:17 House overnight. Recently, there have been more children from their homes than the Isaiah 1:17 has room for so they've been sleeping at the DCS office, which is not equipped to host them.

PRAY that God would move his people step up to care for foster kids in our community.

PRAY *for* OUR WORLD

Use the following prayer prompts to ask God to work and move in our world.

PRAY that God would break down walls of division between people and grow the Church into a visibly reconciled family across ethnic, economic, educational, political, and social barriers.

PRAY that God would open the eyes of global leaders to justice and mercy, so decisions about borders, trade, and migration protect the vulnerable and reflect God's heart.

PRAY that the Church worldwide would be filled with the fullness of Christ, so our worship, witness, and service become a healing presence in places of conflict and poverty.

PRAY that God would raise up and sustain faithful intercessors in every nation, from city prayer rooms to remote villages, who pray without ceasing for their neighbors and rulers.

PRAY that God would tear down spiritual strongholds that enslave people (fear, corruption, idolatries, etc.) and release the freedom of the gospel in closed and hurting places.

PRAY that God would strengthen those who serve among refugees, the displaced, and the marginalized, supplying wisdom, resources, protection, and deep compassion.

PRAY that God would give bold and humble partnership across cultures and denominations, so Christian witness and practical love (education, health, justice, etc.) bear lasting fruit in every region.
